Note 3: Subject to the provisions of the Information Memorandum, this auction will be eligible for the Post Auction Option Facility of an additional amount of the Gilt equivalent to 15% of the nominal amount of the Gilt allocated at the auction. Note 4: The Gilt may not be stripped and reconstituted until so specified in a notice issued by the DMO.
