In each case, the amount issued on 24th January 1992 represents a further tranche of the relevant Stock, ranking in all respects *pari passu* with that Stock and subject to the terms and conditions applicable to that Stock, and subject also to the provision contained in the final paragraph of this notice; the current provisions for Capital Gains Tax are described below.

The Index figure relevant to any month is that published seven months previously and relating to the month before the month of publication.  $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent Index-Linked Treasury Stock 2001 and $2\frac{1}{2}$ per cent Index-Linked Treasury Stock, 2009 are each specified under paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Capital Gains Tax Act 1979 as a gilt-edged security (under current legislation exempt from tax on capital gains, irrespective of the period for which the Stock is held).
